Tenterden Social Hub was formed in 1980 as Tenterden & District Day Centre. We aim to look after the elderly, disabled and people suffering with dementia in the local area. Our structure allows for us to develop supportive services both on and off site. These services enable people to have a better quality of life and promotes independent living.

To obtain a formal RICS Red Book Valuation Report to allow scoping work to be completed for a project based at East Cross.
