Ivy Court Surgery – Temporary Cover for Patients

In preparation for the Winter weather, which seems to have already started in earnest, Ivy Court Surgery have asked for the Town Council's permission to put up a wooden structure by the portacabins.

The structure will be located from the ramp which leads into the portacabins and out across the footpath by around 3m (full dimensions to be tabled). There will be no sides to the cover; it will just protect patients from the rain.

I have asked Ivy Court to ensure they have insurance to cover this structure and also to check with ABC Planning whether they need permission to install this given that it will straddle the conservation area.

The Surgery did explore the option of a marquee tunnel, but this could raise issues with anti-social behaviour and possibly vandalism.

Proposal: To consider allowing the Surgery to put up a wooden structure subject to no objections from ABC Planning.
