

External Committee 14th December 2020
Recommendations from High Street Regeneration Sub-committee

At the Sub-committee's meeting held on 12th November 2020, several recommendations were made for Council approval.

1. Concept Drawings for Tenterden High Street. The Sub-committee would like Town Council's approval to seek Kent County Council's views on the proposed drawings with a view to possibly taking these to public consultation via an exhibition at the end of April/beginning of May 2021.
2. Footpath Link from K&ESR to High Street. The Sub-committee would like the Town Council to write to St. Mildred's Church to seek permission to reinstate the footpath that runs through Coombe Lane Cemetery, with no cost to the Church.
3. Bridewell Lane & Highbury Lane One-way System and Automatic Number Plate Recognition Parking. The Sub-committee supports the one-way system and recommends entering via Highbury Lane and exiting via Bridewell Lane. The Sub-committee would like the Town Council to take the project forward with the incorporation of the ANPR parking system in Bridewell Lane car park at the same time, with a view to it all being implemented by the end of 2021.

Proposals: (i) to seek KCC's views on the proposed concept drawings of the high street and to possibly take to public consultation in April/May 2021; (ii) to write to St. Mildred's Church requesting permission to reinstate the footpath through Coombe Lane Cemetery; (iii) to take forward the one-way system for Bridewell & Highbury Lanes in conjunction with the installation of an ANPR car parking system at Bridewell Lane Car Park.
